


Evaluation of Employer Engagement

New Brief in the Strategies for Transformative Change Series

The OCCRL team has put together brief summaries of the scaling strategies employed by four TAACCCT consortia. The documents describe the strategy and include any available evidence of its success. The newest brief, Business & Industry Leadership Teams, focuses on the National Information, Security, and Geospatial Technology Consortium (NISGTC). This seven member national consortium is collaborating to prepare students for employment in four information technology (IT) specialty areas: programming,

networking and convergence technology, cybersecurity, and geospatial technologies. Building on the model provided by the National Science Foundation Convergence Technology Center, the consortium has developed a Business & Industry Leadership Team (BILT) for each specialty area.
